

Paroba College Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund 30 Day Report

1. Paroba College signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Paroba College has received \$83,707 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. As of the writing of this report, a total of \$56,250 of Emergency Financial Aid Grants have been distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The remaining funds are held back in order provide grants to formerly ineligible students who become eligible due to a change of circumstance or government policy or for future grants should additional COVID-19 related closure be necessary.
4. As of the writing of this report, an estimated 75 students at Paroba College are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
5. As of the writing of this report, 75 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
6. Financial Aid staff members determined student eligibility. To qualify for a grant, a student must
 - Be eligible to apply for Title IV funding in a Title IV eligible program. Neither completing the FAFSA or accepting Title IV aid is required to receive this grant.
 - Have started school at Paroba College on or before March 16, 2020, and returned to campus-based-learning upon its resumption or completed their hours via online learning during the coronavirus related campus closure. Participation in online learning during the closure was not required and does not impact eligibility.
7. This grant was not awarded via a competitive process. All Paroba College students who meet the above listed criteria receive a grant in the same amount. There are no additional instructions at this time.
